- Must not hold any other title

### **Qualifications:**

- Must be a female US citizen, **and** a resident of Warren County **and** have participated in or attended the Warren County Fair
- Must be at least age 12 but no older than 15 years of age by June 1, 2022
- Must be single, never married, have no children and must not marry, nor get pregnant during her reign
- Must have never committed or have been arrested or convicted of a crime
- Have parent or guardian's consent
- Must complete an application and participate in orientation and judging activities
- Prepare a 2 minute speech on "Why you should come to the Warren County Fair"
- Judges will interview each contestant
- Poise and appearance will be considered
- Each contestant will be asked an impromptu question
- Must follow all rules as set forth by the PA State Fair Queen Program, including dress code
- Must have and demonstrate a personal knowledge of the Warren County Fair and agriculture
