NOTE: To enter computer CLASS number, ADD the breed number to the CLASS number for the class listed below. For example, if the breed is Belgian (100) and class is Filly breed is Belgian (100) and class is Filly Foal (12) you would add 100 + 12, therefore, the CLASS number would be 112. If no breed is listed use the CLASS number only.

# Rules and Regulations PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE VOIDED 90 DAYS AFTER THEY ARE PRINTED There is to be no permanent eating or sleeping areas in the barns.

1. Warren County Fair animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. Appropriate documentation of necessary immunizations must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds for all animals. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Warren County Fair Premium Book.

- 2. Exhibitors must specify on the entry form the number of tie stalls or box stalls requesting.
- 3. No horse or team of horses shall be entitled to a

premium unless serviceably sound.

- 4. Horses entered as matched pairs must have one exhibitor.
- 5. Animals or combination of animals owned by one exhibitor may be entered in the classes below.
- 6. No grade stallions shall be accepted for entry.
- 7. Farm horses should not have scotch plates or scotch housing.
- 8. All animals entered **must** compete and be shown in halter class and hitch class if broken.
- 9. In no case is it permissible to show mixed breeds in the same class or section to be judged against each other for premiums.
- 10. General rules and regulations governing the fair will be followed.
- 11. The Fair Board reserves the right to refuse any or all entries.
- 12. No horse showing clinical signs of any contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to any show. (SEE HEALTH RULES
- 13. Percherons show first on odd years, Belgians show first on even years.
- 14. Any equine may be subject to blood test.
- 15. This Department is open to draft animals only.
- 16. Animals shown in this Department cannot be shown in any other Department.
- 17. All trailers will be parked in an area so designated by the Fair Board.
- 18. No ribbons, trophies, awards equipment or exhibit may be removed at any time before the close of the fair or Department.
- 19. It is teamsters' responsibility to be ready for their class.

- 3. All hitches must be judged, not merely brought in for exhibition purposes, and must remain for the duration of the fair.
- 4. Each exhibitor must make arrangements to have a cart or suitable vehicle to hitch.
- 5. Scoring for the judging of all hitch classes is as follows:

60% Manners and per Conformation 20% Confirmation (appearance of horse or horses)

20% Appointments (wagon, harness)

- 6. Same horses cannot be shown in Class 10 and 12.
- 7. Women showing in Class 11 may not show in class 13.
- 8. Multiple horse hitches must be approved by the Hitch Committee by Tuesday at 2:00pm.

- 1. Warren County Fair animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Warren County Fair Premium Book.
- 2. General rules & regulations governing the fair will be followed.
- 3. Warren County Fair Code of Ethics must be followed.
- 4. Proper attire is required in all classes as per the fair regulations.
- 5. The Fair Board reserves the right to refuse any or all entries.
- 6. All trailers will be parked in an area so designated by the Fair Board.
- 7. This Department is open to Miniature Horses only.
- 8. Animals shown in this Department cannot be shown in any other Department.
- 9. A Copy of current Coggins, Rabies, CVI and Registration Papers (if applicable) must be provided to a committee member by Tuesday of the fair.
- 10. No horse shall be entitled to a premium unless serviceably sound.
- 11. No horse showing clinical signs of any contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to any show. (SEE HEALTH RULES)
- 12. Any equine may be subject to blood test.
- 13. Stalls are assigned at the discretion of the committee. Stall assignments will be available upon arrival to the fairgrounds.
- 14. Each animal must have an Exhibitor/Animal Name Card displayed on their stall. The card shall

remain on the stall until the animal is removed from the Fairgrounds.

- 15. No grade stallions shall be accepted for entry.
- 16. All animals must be 40" or under to qualify to exhibit at the Fair in all driving and in-hand classes.
- 17. The committee reserves the right to measure any animal of questionable height. If an animal is found to be over the allowable height, the animal will be disqualified and not allowed to exhibit or collect premiums.
- 18. All registration papers must be up to date and current. If papers are not up to date and current, the animal can be exhibited in the unregistered division but MUST be measured.
- 19. All animals entered must compete and be shown in halter class and cart class if broken.
- 20. Animals or combination of animals owned by one exhibitor may be entered in the classes below.
- 21. In no case is it permissible to show mixed breeds in the same class or section to be judged against each other for premiums.
- 22. No ribbons, trophies, awards, equipment, or exhibit may be removed at any time before the close of the Fair or Department.
- 23. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be ready for their classes.
- 24. Exhibitors are to handle animals in a safe and respectful manner to ensure the safety of others, themselves, and the animals.
- 25. The committee reserves the right to ask any unmanageable animals to be returned to the barns or removed from the Fairgrounds at any time.
- 26. Stallions over 1 year to be exercised and/or shown by a person over the age of 18 years old as of January 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 27. Please note on the entry form if a youth or pee wee will be showing an animal entered in the fair by an adult exhibitor. This will help with ensuring proper class entries and scheduling.
- 28. Any premiums for youth or Pee-Wee exhibitors, if applicable, will be distributed to the adult exhibitor who entered the animal in the WCF. Unless the youth or pee wee has entered the animal under their name.
- 29. Any exhibitor 5 years and under as of January 1st will qualify for the Pee-Wee division, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 30. Pee-Wee exhibitors are required to have an adult in the show ring during exhibition.
- 31. All Pee-Wee and youth exhibitors must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

### MINIATURE HORSE PERFORMANCE CLASSES

- 1. Horses may be purebred or grade but must have been shown in the appropriate preceding individual class and adhere to the height requirements of the department. In-hand Trail, In-Hand Hunter Jumper, and Showmanship do not count as required preceding halter classes.
- 2. All hitches must be judged, not merely brought in for exhibitions purposes, and must remain for the duration of the fair.
- 3. Each exhibitor must make arrangements to have a cart or suitable vehicle to hitch.
- 4. Youth 13 and under are required to have an adult with them in cart classes.
- 5. Exhibitors who show in the youth cart classes will not be permitted to show in the ladies or men's cart classes.
- 6. Pee-Wee riders are required to wear a riding helmet and have well-suited tack for the rider (saddle and bridle) in lead-line class.

- 4. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will be cause of disqualification.
- 5. All horses will be weighed if demanded by Fair Manager.
- 6. All contestants must pay regular gate admission.
- 7. Any equine may be subject to a blood test and Veterinary examination.
- 8. A Social Security number is required for all contestants.
