APPLICATIONS FOR ALL OTHER ENTRIES  
MUST BE MADE ON OR BEFORE JULY 31  
TO WARREN COUNTY FAIR, BOX 230,  
PITTSFIELD, PA 16340.

ALL STILL ENTRIES MUST BE IN PLACE  
BY 8PM. SUNDAY. STILL EXHIBITS  
CANNOT BE REMOVED UNTIL BETWEEN  
1 AND 3PM SUNDAY. DAIRY ANIMALS  
MUST BE IN PLACE BY 8PM ON MONDAY.  
YOUTH LIVESTOCK AUCTION ANIMALS  
MUST BE IN PLACE BY 5PM ON MONDAY.  
HORSES AND REMAINING LIVESTOCK  
MUST BE IN PLACE BY 7AM TUESDAY.  
LIVESTOCK, DAIRY, AND HORSES  
CANNOT BE REMOVED BEFORE 11PM  
SATURDAY. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE  
ACCEPTED ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-  
ENTERED. If there is a question that a certain  
item will be ready or not at fair time, pre-enter  
anyway. PRE-ENTER BY PROPER CLASS  
AND DESCRIPTION AS LISTED IN BOOK.  
AN ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY THE  
ENTRY BLANK IF APPLICABLE.  
ALL TRAILERS WILL BE PARKED IN AN  
AREA SO DESIGNATED BY THE FAIR  
BOARD. NO RIBBONS, TROPHIES,  
AWARDS, EQUIPMENT OR EXHIBIT MAY  
BE REMOVED AT ANY TIME BEFORE THE  
CLOSE OF THE FAIR OR DEPARTMENT.

NOTE: To enter CLASS number follow the rules  
for open class events pertaining to animals. All

other entries use the SECTION AND CLASS  
number listed for the class.

NOTE: Champion ribbons will be awarded only  
when 3 or more animals are in the class.  
ELIGIBILITY: Exhibitors must be members of a  
regularly organized Warren County 4-H Club or  
special interest group carrying a project in the  
field they wish to make entry and be under the  
supervision of the Pennsylvania State University  
Extension 4-H by June 1, preceding the Fair.

Students enrolled in an accepted Warren County  
Vocational School curriculum must be  
conducting a project in the class in which they  
wish to make an entry. Students enrolled in  
general home economics in a comprehensive  
high school are considered as qualifying. All  
entries shall be approved prior to the Fair by a  
member of the Pennsylvania Department of  
Education, Agriculture and Home Economics  
staff or their designated representative.

## eating or sleeping areas in the barns.

1. Warren County Fair Animal Health rules are to be followed in all animal departments & contests. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Warren County Fair Premium Book. Please read carefully and note that out of state rabbits require a CVI in order to enter at the Warren County Fair.

2. Warren County Fair is not responsible for any rabbit that may be injured or dies during the fair.

3. 4-H rabbits must be fed and watered By owner (4-H member).

4. Upon arrival at the fair, the member will be responsible for handling, care, fitting and showing of their animal. No adult is permitted to prepare the animal for fitting or showing in Department 10. Failure to follow this rule could result in forfeiture of premiums. All 4-H animal science youth are required to participate in training regarding "Quality Animal Management" annually. All youth are required to complete a survey regarding these practices.

5. Any rabbit that shows signs of sickness (before or after entries) will be removed from the barn.

6. Rabbits will be judged according to the ARBA guidelines (standard).

7. Rabbit must be permanently earmarked according to ARBA rules.

8. No Rabbits will be bred during the fair.

9. An entry fee of \$0.50 per animal (\$2.00 minimum) must accompany the entry.

10. Rabbits can be entered in open and 4-H classes.

11. Cloverbud 4-H members will be permitted to participate in the Cloverbud showmanship class. The Cloverbud members do not need to own the animal they are showing. No placings or premiums will be given for the class. Cloverbud 4-H members must register through zSuites by June 1 to be eligible to participate.
