The Health Certificate shall include negative date of Coggins test, which must have been conducted within 12 months of opening date of the fair at which the equine is to be exhibited.

4. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will be cause of disqualification.

5. All horses will be weighed if demanded by Fair Manager.

6. All contestants must pay regular gate admission.

7. Any equine may be subject to a blood test and Veterinary examination.

8. A Social Security number is required for all contestants.
