PRE-ENTER BY PROPER CLASS AND DESCRIPTION.

NOTE: To enter computer CLASS number ADD the breed number to the CLASS number for the classes listed below. For example, if the breed is Cheviot (360) and class is Pen of Lambs (14) you would add 360 plus 14, therefore, the CLASS number would be 374. If no breed is listed use the CLASS number only.

Rules and Regulations PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE VOIDED 90 DAYS AFTER THEY ARE PRINTED

There is to be no permanent eating or sleeping areas in the barns.

 Warren County Fair animal health rules are to be followed in all animal departments and contests. The complete requirements are listed in the front of the Warren County Fair Premium Book.
 Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fairgrounds.

3. Ownership - Animals must be the bonafide property of and owned by the exhibitor. All animals entered in group and pair classes must be owned & exhibited by exhibitor. This name must appear on the entry card.

4. All animals, regardless of age must be purebred. Crossbreeds and natural black are open any breed of animal. Animals must have been property of the exhibitor at least thirty (30) days prior to the fair.

5. All sheep will be washed, properly fitted and trimmed. No patch shearing or patch trimming.
6. Drenching, force or bottle feeding of any sheep or lamb, or use of icing and/or any temperature altering products, including but not limited to wet towels, will result in disqualification of the exhibitor from show/sale and exhibit will be removed from the fair. Additionally any animal found with towels draped on it show day, or entering the show ring wet will be presumed in violation of this rule and disqualified.

7. All blankets to be removed after judging until leaving the fair.

8. Each exhibitor will be limited to two (2) entries in each individual class; each entry shall be listed separately.

9. Entry fee- \$1.50 per animal. No entry fee on group classes, but each animal in the group must be entered in its individual class. Fee must accompany the entry blank.

10. Ages for all classes will be determined as of September 1st of each year.

11. All trailers will be parked in an area so designated by the Fair Board.

12. No ribbons, trophies, awards, equipment or exhibit may be removed at any time before the close of the Fair or Department.

SECTION 2 OPEN CLASS MARKET LAMBS WETHERS

 Animals shown in breeding classes cannot be shown in market lamb classes or vice versa.
 The lambs will be divided as equally as possible into three weight classes. All lambs will be weighed at the fair. Any lamb under 80 pounds will be shown as a feeder lamb and any lamb over 170 pounds will be shown in the overweight division. 3. Weigh-in to be done beginning at 6:00pm on Monday of the fair.

4. All lambs must be born on or after January 1st of current year.

5. All lambs showing in Section 2 must be available for weigh in on Monday beginning at 5 PM.
