## SECTION 2

### HAY

Long hay only. An exhibit shall consist of a bale  
section at least 8 inches thick or an equivalent  
amount if cut from hay in the mow.

Class

1. Alfalfa or alfalfa grass mixed, first cutting. Not  
over 50% of grasses.

2. Alfalfa or alfalfa grass mixed, later cuttings.  
Not over 50% of grasses.

3. Other legumes or legume grass mixtures. Not  
over 50% of grasses.

4. Grass, first cutting. Mixtures of timothy and or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes.

5. Grass, second cutting. Mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes.

6. 2nd Cutting Legume other than alfalfa not more than 50% grasses

7. Mixed hay - any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contains 50% or more singly or in combination of alfalfa, timothy, clover and grasses.

8. Summer annual grasses - Sudan grass, Sorghum-Sudan, hybrids, etc.

9. Grand Champion hay exhibit (from above only)  
Ribbon

10. \$20 will be awarded for Judges Choice for Best Display of Hay in memory of Duane Benedict by Chris & Diane Payne.

## **SECTION 3**

### **SILAGE**

Silage crop must be named. Exhibits shall consist of two pounds. (Gallon size plastic bags are excellent containers for transporting or showing samples.)

#### **Class**

1. Perennial crops - direct cut, with or without preservatives.

2. Perennial crops - wilted or low moisture, with or without preservatives.

3. Annuals other than corn - direct cut, with or without preservatives.

4. Annuals other than corn - wilted or low, moisture, with or without preservatives.

5. Corn silage

6. Corn Silage - High Moisture
