PRE-ENTER BY PROPER CLASS AND DESCRIPTION.

Rules and Regulations

PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE VOIDED 90 DAYS AFTER THEY ARE PRINTED

Only one entry per class.

1. The original work in each class must have been done by the exhibitor. (Original means created by the artist – not copied)
2. Judging guidelines:

- A. Composition or design
- B. Workmanship or technique
- C. Form
- D. Suitability
- E. Final presentation

3. PAINTINGS AND DRAWINGS MUST BE MATTED OR FRAMED AND PROPERLY WIRED FOR HANGING. ***If artwork is framed and or matted it must be no more than 3” larger than original art work.***

4. PHOTOGRAPHY All Photos must be 8X10 in size only. No matting or framing will be accepted. Plastic sleeves & hangers will be provided.

5. Woodwork judging will be based on originality, design, surface finish, skill, and execution of final presentation.

6. Pottery and ceramics to be signed and dated.

7. Crafts – Excellent kit work will be accepted. Preference in judging will be given to creative and original work except hand wrought means completely made by hand.

8. Work must not have been entered in any previous Warren County Fair.
